NOTICE OF RACE

RULES-The regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. All US Sailing Prescriptions and Flying Scot® Class Rules shall apply except for bow bag and transom port requirements, but they are recommended. The Sailing Instructions will be available Saturday morning at registration. State law requires a USCG approved PFD for each person on board, and a throw-able cushion.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to boats of the Flying Scot® class. Membership in F.S.S.A. is strongly urged. This is to promote a healthy class association thereby increasing the value of boat ownership for everyone.

Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it together with the required fee as provided on the attached form. Early registration is encouraged for planning purposes. Thank you!

5 VENUE
