

## **NOTICE OF RACE (NOR)**

## Flying Scot® 2023 Egyptian Cup Regatta



## June 14-16, 2024 Fleet 83, Carlyle Lake Sailing Association (CSA) Carlyle Lake, Illinois

**Rules**: This regatta will be governed by the 2021-2024 RACING RULES OF SAILING, except as modified by applicable FSSA class rules and/or the Sailing Instructions.

**Eligibility**: The Egyptian Cup Regatta is open to all Flying Scots. The skipper of the boat must be a member of FSSA to participate.

**Registration**: You must register completely online. Links to registration are available <u>here</u>. We will not have registration at CSA and you must be registered at the latest by Friday, June 14, 2024 at 5 pm in order to participate.

**Measurement:** All boats may be checked for safety equipment and sail compliance as required by the FSSA class rules.

**Fees**: The registration entry fee is \$125 and includes all meals for two people. Additional meal packages may be purchased for \$50.

## Schedule:

Friday, June 14	4:00pm 6:00pm	Early arrivals; set up boats and tents. Welcome dinner.
Saturday, June 15	8:00-9:00am 9:00am 10:30am TBD TBD 6:00pm	Breakfast. Competitors meeting. First race warning signal. Second race to follow. Lunch break on shore. Two more races as conditions permit. Dinner served in the OB or pavilion.
Sunday, June 16	8:00-9:00am 9:30am 11:25am 1:00pm	Breakfast. First race warning signal. Second race to follow. No warning signal after this time. Lunch followed by awards.

**Disclaimer of Liability**: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. Neither the organizing authority nor the host organization will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Every boat owner is expected to carry boat owners insurance. All skippers and crew must sign a waiver of liability prior to sailing in order to be eligible to compete in the regatta.

**Sailing Instructions**: Sailing instructions will be available online only, so please print them before arrival. Should the Sailing Instructions conflict with this NOR, the Sailing Instructions shall govern.

**VHF Radios**: The race committee may use VHF radios for courtesy communications with participants. See Class Rules, Article S-V, paragraph 7 for more information.

**Accommodations**: Entry fee includes free primitive camping on CSA grounds in either a tent or single vehicle footprint (car, van, or pickup truck parked in car parking lot). No hookups are available and no camping trailers (including pop ups) will be allowed on CSA grounds. Hookups and pop-up trailer camping are available in the state park just outside CSA on a first come first serve basis. There are also hotels in Carlyle and in Greenville, Illinois.

**Venue**: Racing will take place on Carlyle Lake. Launching will be at the Carlyle Sailing Association. Boats will be stored on trailers on the CSA grounds in the appropriately marked areas. Be sure to bring extra lines to tie your boat and trailer down to the parking lot.

**Scoring**: Up to six races may be sailed in the regatta. No races will be excluded from a boat's series score. This changes RRS rule A2, Appendix A. Low Point Scoring System shall be used. One race will constitute a regatta.

**Awards**: Trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew of the top five finishers. The Egyptian Cup champion will be awarded the Egyptian Cup perpetual trophy (non traveling).
