Organizing Authority: Lake Monona Sailing Club ("LMSC")

1. RULES:

- 1.1 This event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* ("RRS") and (i) for Flying Scot class boats the FSSA Class Rules, (ii) for other participating boats, their applicable class rules (FSSA Class Rules and other applicable class rules, together "Class Rules").
- 1.2 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.1 and 63.2 will not apply.
- 1.3 ELIGIBILITY:
- 1.3 The event is open to all (i) Flying Scot Class boats and (ii) other classes of craft sailed in LMSC, i.e., MC Scows, C-Scows, catamarans (together, "LMSC One Design Boats"). LMSC One Design Boats will participate in a separate fleet and will have a separate start ("LMSC One Design Fleet").
- 1.4 For a separate LMSC One Design Fleet to be raced, at least five entrants must be registered as LMSC One Design Boats by the close of registration on Saturday, July 13.
- 1.5 Competitors must complete the following by the close of registration, unless otherwise specified below, before a boat's entry will be accepted:
 - 1.5.1 The registration form must be completed in full.
 - 1.5.2 Event registration fees must be paid in full.

2. REGISTRATION AND CHECK-IN:

- 2.1 Registration may be done online at www.lakemononasailing.com and on-site at Olbrich Park regatta headquarters.
- 2.2 Registration will close and registration must be completed by 0930, July 13, 2024.
- 2.3 Check-in at the on-site registration is required prior to (i) 1000 Friday July 12, if participating in the Friday race clinic; (ii) 0930 Saturday July 13, if participating in the regatta and not checked in for the Friday race clinic. Copies of the Sailing Instructions (SI), Notice of Race (NOR), will be available at regatta headquarters at Olbrich Park.



3. FEES:

- 3.1 The entry fee for the 2024 Madison Clinigatta includes the following for the helmsperson and one crew:
 - 3.1.1 Friday-Sunday launch ramp permit for the Olbrich Park boat ramps;
 - 3.1.2 Parking for one vehicle and trailer at the Olbrich Park boat ramps (additional vehicle parking is available across the street):
 - 3.1.3 Friday evening WELCOME PARTY and cookout at the University of Wisconsin Hoofers Sailing Club*;
 - 3.1.4 Friday, Saturday, and Sunday continental breakfast at Olbrich Park;
 - 3.1.5 Friday, Saturday, and Sunday box lunches;
 - 3.1.6 Saturday evening cook out (location TBD);
 - 3.1.7 Beer and snacks will be available for purchase after racing daily at the Olbrich Park Biergarten, and on the Memorial Union Terrace at the Friday welcome party. Beer and soft drinks will be provided at the Saturday evening party;
 - 3.1.8 Additional guest/meal/social wristbands covering the entire event will be available for purchase;
 - 3.1.9 CLINIGATTA RAFFLE TICKET. Each boat entered will receive a complimentary entry in the CLINIGATTA RAFFLE.**
- 3.2 **Event Apparel.** Apparel can be purchased on-line at www.CoralReefSailing.com prior to the event for pickup at the event. Please see the registration page at www.lakemononasailing.com for available items and more details.

4. RACE SCHEDULE:

- 4.1 No limit to the number of races sailed each day. Our goal is to sail as many short, approximately 30 minute, windward-leeward twice-around courses as possible given the conditions.
- 4.2 For a list of events, dates, and times, see the Regatta Schedule at the end of this NOR.

5. REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

- 5.1 Boats and sails must conform to the specifications in the applicable Class Rules.
- 5.2 Each boat shall carry safety equipment required by the FSSA (for Flying Scot class boats) and the US Coast Guard.

6. VENUE:

6.1 The race area will be on the waters of Lake Monona. Regatta Headquarters, boat launching, and trailer storage will be located at Olbrich Park, on the east end of Lake Monona:

7. PENALTY SYSTEM:

8.1 RRS Appendix V, Alternative Penalties, Rules V1 and V2 will be in effect.

8. REGATTA PRIZES:

- 8.1 Trophies will be awarded as follows:
 - 8.1.1 1st through 3rd place, Flying Scot Division, helmsperson and crew.
 - 8.1.2 1st through 3rd place, LMSC One Design Division, helmsperson and crew.

9. BERTHING/PARKING/LAUNCHING:

- 9.1 Lake Monona is bounded by the City of Madison to the north and the City of Monona to the south.
- 9.2 Olbrich Park and the Olbrich Park boat landing are located at the east end of Lake Monona.
- 9.3 Boats visiting from out of town will be berthed/parked at Olbrich Park. Local boats will be berthed at LMSC piers at Stonebridge Park, Olin Park, or private residences, as applicable.
- 9.4 The Olbrich Park boat landing has three public piers and six launch lanes. There is no crane; boats must be ramp launched.
- 9.5 Boats and trailers sailing from Olbrich Park shall be kept at their assigned places in the reserved area of the Olbrich Park boat launch parking lot. All boats shall be hauled out every night unless no haul out has been approved by the RC.
- 9.6 Vehicles with trailers parked in the Olbrich Park boat launch parking lot must display a Dane County Boat Launch Permit at all times (permits are included with registration).
- 9.7 Boats can be dropped off at Olbrich Park any time after 1700 July 11, 2024. Boats must be removed from the Olbrich Park parking lot grounds by 0900 July 15, 2024. Special requests for earlier boat drop off or later boat retrieval can be made with the Regatta Chair.
- 9.8 The piers at Olbrich Park are for the general use of the public. Please be courteous to other ramp users and do not leave your boats unattended at the pier.
- 9.9 If there is an onshore lunch break at Olbrich Park or should there be a mid-day weather delay such that boats must return to shore, boats must be hauled out.
- 9.10 If there is an onshore lunch break at Stonebridge Park, boats may raft off the LMSC pier or anchor nearby (anchoring crews will be shuttled to shore). Boats berthed at Stonebridge Park may return their boat to a boat lift.
- 9.11 The channel exiting Olbrich Park is narrow, and depending on water levels, can be shallow. If the channel is not navigable for safely sailing in and out of the harbor, towboats will be provided by the Organizing Authority. In the event of low water, competitors sailing in and out of the harbor may need to raise their centerboard and rudder.

10. SUPPORT BOATS, COACHES, HELMSPERSONS, REPLACEMENT CREW:

- 10.1 Competitors may receive support and coaching from official event support boats between and during races.
- 10.2 Event-provided coaches will be allowed aboard competitors' boats during racing and may act as helmsperson or crew.
- 10.3 Crew substitutions will be liberally allowed.
- 10.4 There is no requirement that the same person serve as helmsperson of a competing boat for all races in the series.
- 10.5 <u>These provisions alter provisions of Class Rules and RRS.</u>

11. RADIO COMMUNICATION:

- 11.1 The race committee may use VHF radios to communicate with competitors while racing.
- 11.2 All boats shall carry a VHF-FM marine radio in working condition.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

- 12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta and all events associated with it. RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.
- 12.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000 per incident or the equivalent. Proof of insurance may be requested by the Organizing Authority.

- 1. Housing. Limited housing is available at LMSC members' homes. Contact Dave Gorwitz, 608-320-3366, dave@gorwitz.com. Though we can't make any promises, our goal is to provide housing for everyone who requests it. Why stay at a hotel when you can stay at someone's comfortable home!
- 2. Camping. Camping is available at Mad Sails and at the Jim and Jennifer Colgrove Estate. Mad Sails and the Colgrove Estate are each located approximately 25 minute drive from Olbrich Park.
