

Notice of Race

2023 Flying Scot Michigan-Ontario District Championship Saturday Aug. 5 and Sunday Aug. 6 Detroit Yacht Club

Date and Location: The 2023 Flying Scot Michigan-Ontario District Championship will be held Aug. 5 and Aug. 6 at the Detroit Yacht Club, Belle Isle, Detroit, MI. The Saturday racing tentatively will be held in the lower end of Lake St. Clair and the Sunday racing will be held in the Detroit River in the immediate vicinity of the Detroit Yacht Club.

Time: Competitors should arrive at the DYC dock and be rigged no later than 11 a.m. Saturday Aug. 5 for Skipper's Meeting and a tow to lower Lake St. Clair. Racing on Sunday Aug. 6 shall begin at approximately 12 noon.

Divisions: There shall be one division for all competitors.

Cancellations: Race Committee will decide whether conditions permit racing. If racing is cancelled in advance, the committee will attempt to send out an email. If inclement weather prevents sailing on either day, a suitable makeup date will be arranged.

Registration: Advanced registration and fee payment preferred. Registration will be available day of race (Saturday Aug. 5) at the Detroit Yacht Club Flying Scot dock. NOTE: As this is an official Flying Scot regatta, all skippers must be members of the Flying Scot Sailing Association.

Sails: Spinnakers will be permitted for all races.

Scoring: Low-point scoring will be used. Two races shall constitute a series.

Rules: Races will be run under the current US Sailing's Racing Rules of Sailing, modified by Race Committee as needed and announced at the skippers meeting.

Protests: Race Committee will attempt to resolve any protest immediately following racing; if that fails, a protest hearing will be scheduled.
