NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

- 1.1. The Full Moon Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules* of Sailing.
- 1.2. The rules of the Flying Scot Class will apply.
- 1.3. Certain rules may be changed and these changes will appear in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4. By participating in this regatta, a competitor grants to the organizing authority and its sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures, and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

2. Eligibility & Entry

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the Flying Scot Class.
- 2.2. Flying Scot Class Association membership is strongly encouraged.

3. Boats/Measurement

- 3.1. Flying Scots will be used.
- 3.2. Each competitor will be responsible for their boat complying with class rules.

4. Schedule for 2025 Full Moon Regatta/NJYRA Championship at Monmouth Boat Club

Timing	Event
10:30-12:00	Arrivals, rigging and registration
12 PM	Skippers meeting and bag lunch
1 PM – 4 PM	First warning signal and racing
4 PM	No race shall start after 4 PM
5 PM	Beer, wine and barbeque dinner

- 5. Fee The \$60 entry fee includes
 - 5.1. Race entry for skipper and crew.
 - 5.2. A bag lunch, water, and barbeque dinner with wine and beer.
 - 5.3. Please email the chair if you intend to come, so that we may plan accordingly.
- 6. Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.
- 7. **Scoring**–A maximum of five races are scheduled. One completed race shall constitute a regatta. No race scores will be excluded (no throw-outs).
- 8. **Prizes**–Awards will be given to competitors placing first through third place.
- 9. **Disclaimer of Liability**–Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 10. Parking
 - 4.1. No parking inside the fire lanes designated by yellow paint on the blacktop.
 - 4.2. Trailers for visiting boats shall have priority for open space in the boatyard.
 - 4.3. Visiting tow vehicles shall have second priority for space in the yard.
 - 4.4. Remaining competitors should park in the new Red Bank Parking lot on the right side as you are looking at MBC. Note that Google street view and satellite views are not yet updated to the existence of this lot. This is a paid lot. MBC hopes to arrange for discounted parking rates, so please ask us for any updated parking instructions before paying for parking. Free street parking can be found east southeast of the hospital, but it will be several blocks from MBC.

Directions: Take the Garden State Parkway to Exit 109.

From North: Turn left at traffic light, go under parkway and turn left at the second traffic light onto Half Mile Road;

From South: On the Exit 109 ramp, bear right towards Red Bank and then bear left at the fork to proceed straight onto Half Mile Road;

To MBC: Once on Half Mile Road, continue to its end. Turn right at the traffic light onto Front Street, then continue on Front Street through the next light, over the Navesink river bridge, and then through 5 more traffic lights. Then turn left onto Wharf Avenue. This is the 1st left after the last light (Broad Street). Turn left again onto Union Street. Monmouth Boat Club is on the right at the bottom of the hill. Pull your boat trailer through the center gate, where someone will welcome you and show you where to rig up. Follow the parking instructions above for your tow vehicle. Trailers can stay in the MBC boat yard.
