# Notice of Race 2015 Hospitality Regatta October 24 & 25, 2015



The Jackson Yacht Club ("JYC") is pleased to invite all interested sailors to compete in the 2015 Hospitality Regatta to be held at the Jackson Yacht Club located at 700 Yacht Club Road, Ridgeland, MS 39157. Racing will take place on the Ross Barnet Reservoir adjacent to the JYC.

# 1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in <u>The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2013-2016</u> <u>Including US Sailing Prescriptions (RRS)</u>, this Notice of Race, any applicable one-design class rules, the Sailing Instructions and any modifications posted on the day of the race.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY:

The regatta is open to all boats. One-design entries of three or more shall constitute a separate class and may be started and/or scored separately as determined by the principal race officer (PRO). All other entries shall be assigned to a handicap fleet as determined by the PRO. Assignment of fleets and classes cannot be protested. Competitors presenting a valid Gulf Yachting Association (GYA) PHRF certificate for their yacht will be assigned that rating. All others will be assigned a rating by the PRO. Ratings assigned by the PRO may not be protested.

- PHRF Non Spinnaker
- Multi-Hull

#### 4. REGISTRATION AND FEES:

Registration may be accomplished by completing the attached registration form. Additional forms may be obtained by calling JYC at 601-856-8844, or picked up at the registration desk upon arrival.

Regatta Entry Fee, all classes and boats: \$50. The entry fee may be paid in one of the following ways: By check made payable to Jackson Yacht Club, or by cash, check, or credit card at the registration desk prior to the Skippers Meeting. Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover will be accepted. JYC members may charge the fee to their accounts.

Registration Entry Fee includes one JYC Hospitality Regatta T-Shirt, and two tickets to Saturday's JYC Taco Bar Dinner. Additional T-Shirts and dinner tickets are both \$15 each. JYC entry fee includes skipper and all crew for Saturday and Sunday continental breakfast. Lunch on Saturday is available for \$6 per person. Sunday lunch is available from the menu at menu prices or the Sunday Buffet which is \$13.99 per adult and \$7.99 for children under age 12.

# 6. RACES

Five races are planned for the all fleets except PHRF Non-Spinnaker—three on Saturday and two on Sunday. Three races are planned, two Saturday and one Sunday for the PHRF Non-Spinnaker fleet. One race shall constitute the regatta for all fleets.

#### 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting and Registration desk at the JYC club house.

# 8. SCORING:

The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. There will be no scores excluded.

#### 9. AWARDS:

Prizes will be awarded in the JYC club house to the top three finishers in each class.

#### 10. BERTHING:

JYC has over 300 feet of ramp parking, a three ton hoist and also hill parking adjacent to the launching area. There are showers available for use on premise.
